

MINIMUM LEVEL REQUIRED

For registration in small group courses

It is important for you to arrive with the following bases if you want to join a group. Indeed, it is very difficult at an elementary level to integrate an ongoing progression. If you think you have not acquired these basics for your arrival, it is preferable to choose a one-to-one course.

To join a group, you must be able to:

- Introduce yourself and someone else
- Ask and answer questions (*qui, que, où, quand, comment, combien*)
- Talk about everyday life: hobbies, tastes, family, studies, work, etc.
- Describe your environment, talk about the weather
- Knowing how to communicate in a restaurant, store, hotel, doctor's office
- Propose /accept / refuse an invitation, an activity
- Tell about a trip, an outing, a past activity
- Talk about your projects
- Compare
- Express satisfaction, agreement / disagreement, interest

Grammatical content to know:

- The following tenses: present, compound past (*je suis parti*), near future (*je vais partir*), recent past (*je viens de partir*).
- The imperative (*pars, partez*)
- The conditional of politeness (*je voudrais, j'aimerais*)
- The pronouns *cod, coi, y, en*
- The relative pronouns: *qui, que, où*
- The obligation with *il faut*
